THE BLUES MAGOOS - "PSYCHEDELIC RESURRECTION"

The album cover art alone will give you an acid flashback. The Bronx-born Blues Magoos trip was launched in 1966, with the album "Psychedelic Lollipop." It was a pre-metal, rip-roaring, garagey, trippy treat.

Resurrected for this new album, their first in 40 years, are new recordings of some of the influential band's classic tracks, such as "(We Ain't Got) Nothin' Yet," "Tobacco Road" and drug anthem "Pipe Dream." Showing they've got a sense of humour,

the Magoos reflect the fact that Boomers have graduated from LSD and mescaline to Tums and Zantac with the paean to heartburn, "D Stinko Me Tummies on the Blinko." Other winners include "I'm Still Playing," "Gotta Get Away" and "Psyche-Delight." Featuring original members lead vocalist/keyboardist Ralph Scala, vocalist/guitarist Peppy Castro, and drummer Geoff Daking, The Blues Magoos combine these old and new rock tunes to generate a ton of fun.
